5. QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS FROM MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

- 5.1. Stedham with Iping Speed Limit Action Group(SLAG) summarised progress as follows:
 - Advice received from West Sussex Highways is to keep the application simple. Recommendation from SLAG is to make two separate applications, one for Stedham and one for Iping and limit each application to a maximum of two roads per application.
 - Stedham application for 20mph to include 30mph from the A272 into Stedham Lane, reducing to 20mph where the current 30mph signs are by Stedham End, through School Lane and the entrance to the A272. The 20 mph along the Street should continue until north of the entrance to the car park by the river, north of Bridgefoot, where it will be 20mph through to the three-way junction near Tote Lane
 - Iping application for 30mph to cover Iping Lane from access road from A272 through the village to the junction with Hammer Lane, but with a 20mph section to cover from south of Iping Bridge to north of the Church
 - HB(as CDC Councillor) recommended waiting until the new councillor for WSCC is elected in May to obtain endorsement for the application
 - SLAG requested letter of endorsement from SIPC for the latest proposal. <u>SIPC resolved to provide</u> said endorsement. SLAG plan to obtain further endorsements from other relevant organisations within the villages.
 - SLAG requested all to take photographs which illustrate current issues with parking and traffic and forward to the group
 - ACTION: Clerk to forward copy of source map and access to POL to SLAG Group.
